Romans 8:31-34

What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies. Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.

We're asking everyone to set aside time on Wednesday 20th May to praise God, thank Him, and pray for what's to come in the life of our churches.

Some may wish to include fasting—voluntarily giving up food (or other good things) to use that time for prayer and letting hunger remind us of our dependence on God.

During the day you might find it helpful to:

- Set aside specific times for prayer.
- Join a prayer gathering: 7-8am at Café Fifty Five, 12-12.30pm online, 3-4pm at St Mary's (Stoughton), 7.30-8.30pm at St Luke's (Thurnby).
- Use the prayer points provided.
- Pray through each line of the Lord's Prayer.
- Let Romans 8:31-34 or other Bible passages shape your prayers.
- Thank God for specific people in each of the churches, giving thanks for them and praying for them.



PRAYER POINTS

Living Hope Church, Thurmaston

- Praise God for the continued growth of our church community and for our recent awesome Easter that has brought a new family to join us, along with others who have joined so far this year. Pray for more!
- Pray for our Summer Socials in July, particularly Living Hope Camp '26 and all that that goes into that.
- Pray that God will continue to guide us into attaining stability as we move forward.

St Catharine's Church, Houghton

- For evangelistic event at the pub – Hanro Liebenberg (Tigers player) is coming to speak. Pray the Holy Spirit would be at work drawing people to Jesus Christ.
- Pray for Explore as we begin to run Alpha at our sessions.
